### Conditions of entry:

1. All entries must be covered by a Public Liability Policy including rally use having a limit indemnity of not less than £2,000,000 for any one accident.
2. Every driver of a mobile exhibit must hold a current licence to drive that class of vehicle. This includes tractors, under 17s not legally allowed to drive in the rally field as it is open to the public, unless they hold the appropriate licence. Over 17s if not holding a full licence must have 'L' plates displayed.
3. Exhibitors of 16 years and under **MUST** be under the supervision of an adult.
4. Stationary Engine exhibits **must be in the charge of a responsible person whilst running, and not be left unattended.**
5. Whilst the rally organisers sincerely hope that no accidents resulting in injury or loss of life occur at the rally, in the event of this happening, if the exhibitor is found to be negligent, it is that person who would be liable **personally** and not the organisers of the rally.
6. To ensure smooth running on the day, please could copies of boiler certificates be included with entry forms.
7. No children to be allowed to ride on any vehicle unless they would be legally allowed to do so on the public road.
8. The Judge's decision has to be the final word. Only exhibits entered in the catalogue will be judged.
9. Mementos will be available for pre 1972 entries only. Later models may enter, but we're sorry that no mementos can be given.
10. Speed limit will be set at 5mph on site — if this is exceeded you will be asked to leave.
11. All exhibits are to remain on-site until the **end of the day.**
